



Groundwater System: Elmore

The Elmore System only supplies the town of Elmore.

Raw water is supplied from two groundwater bores. Goulburn-Murray Water manages the raw water supply.

Elmore is within the Lower Campaspe Valley Groundwater Management Area, Elmore-Rochester Zone.

Water Summaries are prepared each month to provide current water resource information.

Our Urban Water Strategy outlines our water supply initiatives to meet our region's residential, business and community water needs for the next 50 years.

Our nine supply systems have independent sources of water and supply constraints.

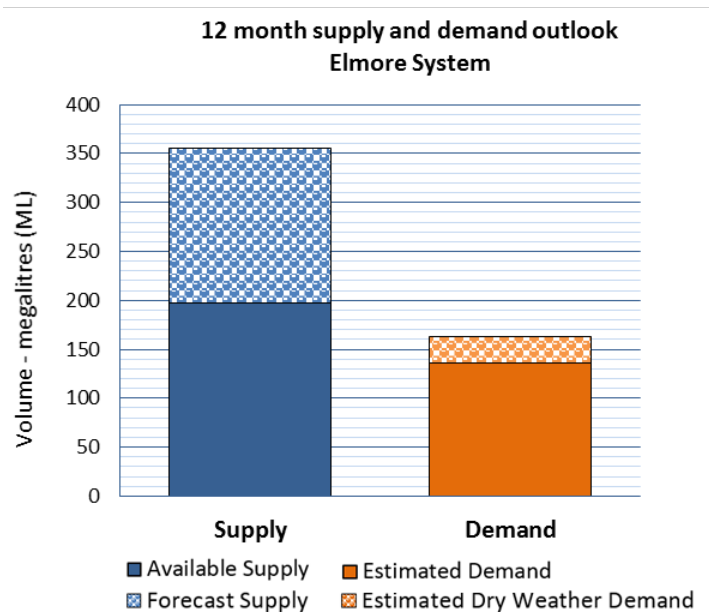


Available raw water supply

¹ From January 2016 we have included carryover from last year in our available raw water supply. Our groundwater licence allows carryover from the previous year. The maximum carryover is 25% of the entitlement volume.

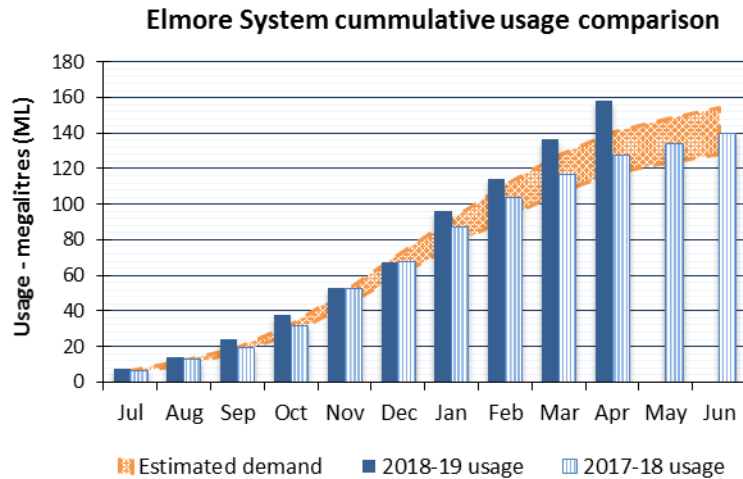
